- Day 2MondayMt. 21:12-22Jesus curses the fig tree and Teaches
in the Temple.
- Day 3 Tuesday Mt. 21:23 23:39 Controversy in the Temple. Olivet Discourse. Last day of Jesus' public ministry.
- Day 4 "Silent" Wednesday Mt. 24:1 26:16 A day of rest at Bethany. There is no record of this in scripture (suggested by scholars.) The readings are events taking place on Tuesday.
- Day 5 "Maundy" Thursday Mt. 26:17-35 These events take place in the "upper room." There they shared the supper and Jesus washed the disciples' feet.
- Day 6"Good" FridayMt. 26:26 27:61
Death of Jesus by crucifixion.
Why is this day called "Good" Friday?Day 7"Silent" SaturdayMt. 27:62-66 and Luke 23:50-56.
- Day 8ResurrectionMt. 28:1-20
- Easter Sunday! See also Acts 1:1-11 and Phil. 3:10!
